**Agency Description:** The Natural Resources Group (NRG) is a division within NYC Parks & Recreation that develops management and acquisition strategies for the restoration and protection of the City's wetlands, woodlands and meadows. The NRG Forest Restoration Team oversees a variety of woodland restoration activities including reforestation, exotic species control and slope stabilization.

**Job Description:** Under supervision, perform natural resource management tasks, including identifying and controlling invasive species, site clearing, planting preparation, and planting trees, shrubs, and herbaceous plants. This work may include the following: operating cars, trucks, and other types of motorized vehicles, use of 2 cycle equipment such as hedge-trimmers and chainsaws, application of herbicide, cutting and carrying woody debris, chipping, maintaining planting sites, equipment and nursery space, training and supervision of volunteers and interns as necessary, and maintaining daily records of work.
