

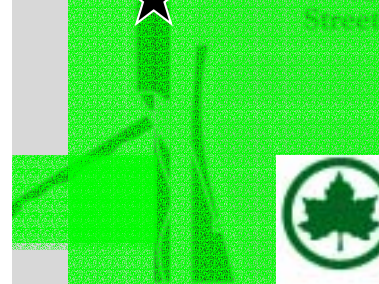
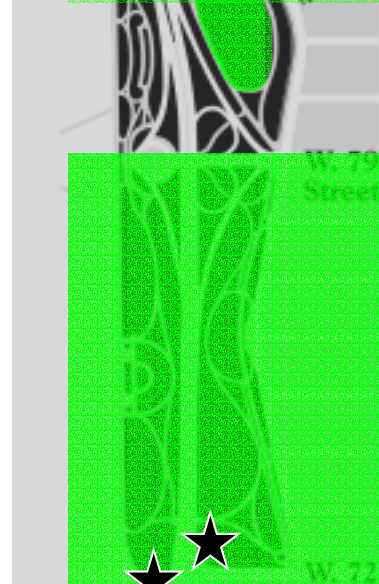
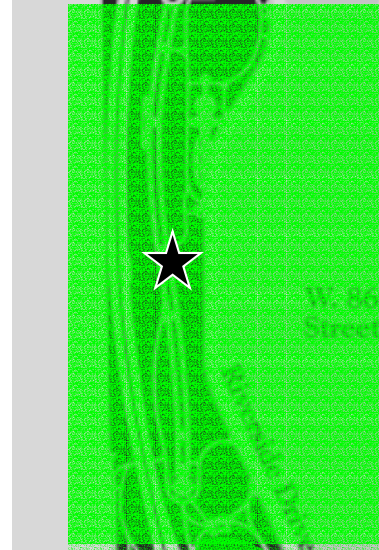
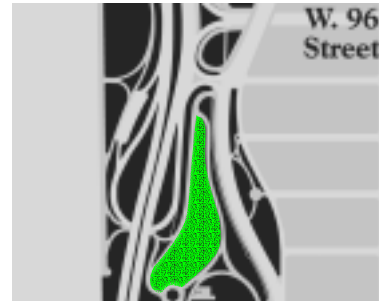
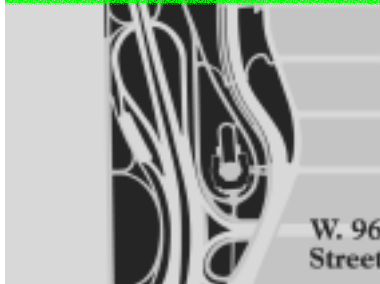
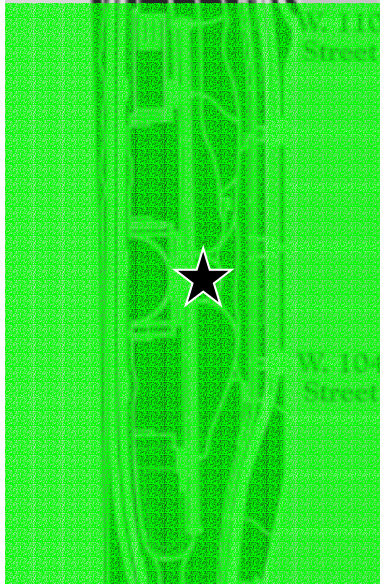
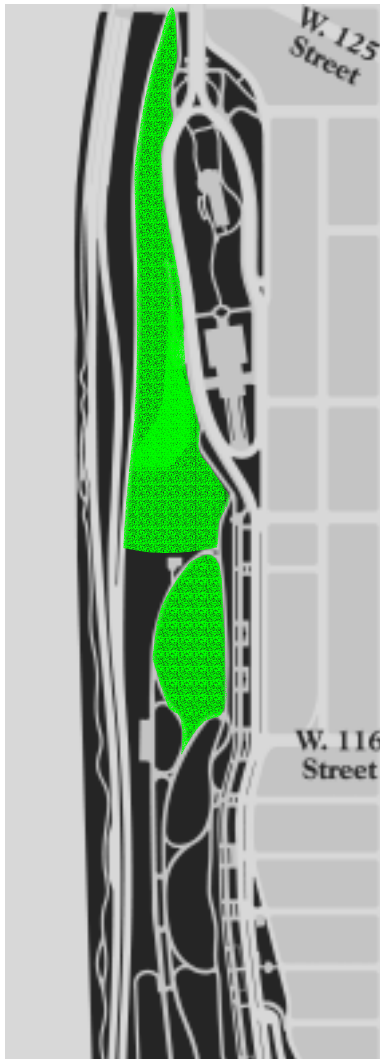
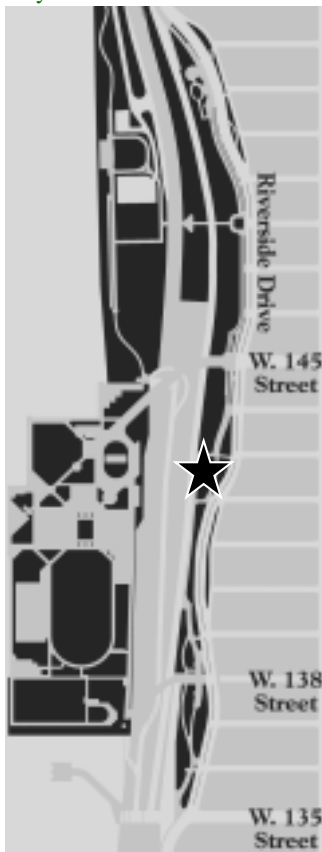
# Dog Owners' Guide To Riverside Park

Riverside Park is home to a thriving, supportive community of dogs and dog owners. Dog runs, located at 71<sup>st</sup>, 72<sup>nd</sup>, 87<sup>th</sup> and 105<sup>th</sup> Street are the anchors of this community. These runs provide safe, well-managed areas for dogs to enjoy off-leash activity. They offer large, fenced-in areas with shade and sun, water fountains, benches and lots of social interaction for dogs and owners. Created with the expertise of a Parks department landscape architect and volunteers, the runs encourage play while supplying good drainage, safe lighting and healthy plantings.

As a courtesy to dog owners, dogs are permitted off-leash from 9 pm to 9 am in most areas of Riverside Park. Dogs are never allowed off-leash below 79<sup>th</sup> Street, between 82<sup>nd</sup> and 91<sup>st</sup> Streets, 100<sup>th</sup> and 110<sup>th</sup> Streets, and in Forever Wild areas.

Dogs are never allowed on ball fields, in playgrounds, or on passive use only lawns.
