The Capital Division at NYC Parks is responsible for managing the design, construction, and administration of capital projects to expand, improve, and revitalize these public spaces.

Major Responsibilities

- Under general direction, supervise a group of Construction Resident Engineers responsible for constructing projects on time and within budget. Responsibilities include but are not limited to, administrative oversight of staff, hiring, training and health and safety.
- Plan, assign and review the work of Construction Resident Engineers.
- Direct contractors on compliance with plans and specifications and approve changes in the field.
- Responsible for State Pollution Discharge Elimination System site inspections.
- Serve as a liaison with other agencies and departments, utility companies, contractors, consultants, community boards and the general public.
- Assist in the monitoring of various contract administrative requirements, including Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) goals and Project Labor Agreements.
- View and comment on contract plan and specifications.
- Review project drawings during design phase (75% 90% complete) for constructability.
- Develop creative solutions to solve problems while working in a variety of conditions and situations.
- May represent the Director of Construction and perform all associate tasks, including supervision of the entire team of Construction Resident Engineers, as needed.

Qualification Requirements

*This vacancy is only open to 1) current permanent city employees serving in the Construction Project Manager civil service title or 2) on leave from the title or 3) reachable on the Construction Project Manager civil service list Exam No. 0169 or 4) permanent city employees in or on leave from a comparable title or 5) employees who are reachable on a comparable civil service list.

- 1. To be eligible for placement in Assignment Level III, individuals must have two additional years of satisfactory full-time experience working in a Construction Project Manager Assignment Level I and II; or two additional years of satisfactory full-time experience (as described in the minimum qualifications of the Construction Project Manager civil service title).
- 2. Candidates must specify for each construction project they worked on, the time period they worked on the construction project, and the type of work they performed. Candidates must also specify the money allotted for the project.

This position is exempt from NYC residency requirements.
